## STATEMENT FROM THE ARMORY SHOW REGARDING CORONAVIRUS

At a time of great global concern and uncertainty, The Armory Show is closely monitoring the evolving situation with the coronavirus. Our hearts go out to those directly affected. As the safety of our exhibitors and guests remains a top priority, we will continue to consult with experts in the field and pursue best practices in safeguarding The Armory Show 2020 edition.

As of now, businesses are open and operating as normal in New York City. US health officials have indicated that risk remains low across the United States, including New York City, advising ordinary flu season precautions, such as regular hand washing. According to a Center for Disease Control (CDC) statement updated February 25, 2020, "at this time, the virus is NOT currently spreading in the community in the United States." Further, the statement indicated that for the general public who are unlikely to be exposed (i.e. are not healthcare workers for, or close family members of, those infected), "the immediate risk of [the virus] is considered low."

The Armory Show 2020 will take place as planned and looks forward to opening its doors next week for its 26th edition. We will continue to monitor updates and advisories from the Center for Disease Control ([CDC](#)) and the World Health Organization ([WHO](#)).
